



REGULAR SPONSORSHIP GUIDELINES

You are being asked to sponsor a person currently an Associate Member of the ACKCSC to become a Regular Member with all voting privileges. This is one of the major responsibilities you have as a Regular Member in good standing. This is a serious matter and we will need to rely on your input for accurate detail regarding this person's suitability for full membership. Please answer all questions in as much detail as possible. Guidelines for sponsorship are below.

GUIDELINES

- Both sponsors must be Regular Members of the ACKCSC in good standing
- Both sponsors must be in good standing with the AKC.
- Only Regular Members are eligible to sponsor Regular Member applicants, and each may sponsor two per calendar year.
- It is preferred that sponsors be two different individuals than those who sponsored the applicant for Associate Membership.
- It is preferred both sponsors have personally known the applicant for at least one year or longer, and have actually met them in person.
- It is preferred at least one of the sponsors has visited the applicant's home and is able to describe the living conditions of the animals from first hand experience.
- It is preferred the sponsor has either worked with this person on some Cavalier related function, for example, Rescue, Dog Shows, All Breed Club, Performance, or committees.
- It is preferred that one or both sponsors will be available to mentor this applicant.
- All applicants and sponsors must read understand the "Ethical Guidelines".
- Sponsor signatures must be dated within 3 months of the date of submission of the application
- Please keep copies of all forms you have signed.
